If we differentiate and explicitly teach spelling, reading fluency and reading comprehension strategies then we will have growth for every student in reading R-6.	Students will become increasingly proficient in selecting and arranging letters to form accurately spelt words, to ensure written texts are clear and easily understood. Students develop increasing skill and knowledge in using spelling as a tool to understand and create meaning in texts. At higher levels of the progression, students monitor their own spelling and explain how spelling affects meaning. (A.C General Capabilities -Literacy: Writing - spelling) Student will become progressively faster, smoother, more accurate and expressive in their reading aloud of increasingly complex print texts. At higher levels of the progression, students demonstrate comprehension of text through confident use of intonation, pausing, accuracy and pace. (A.C General Capabilities -Literacy: Reading and viewing – fluency) Students will become increasingly proficient in decoding, using, analysing and evaluating texts, to build meaning. Students will learn, apply, integrate and adapt strategies and skills as they engage with increasingly complex texts, for a range of purposes. (A.C General Capabilities -Literacy: Reading and viewing – understanding texts)
